

God & Treasures Matthew 6:19-24

“Don’t collect for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal. But collect for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”

Treasures or valuables on earth just don’t last.

Treasures in heaven are what last.

Your heart is the key.

We must check out hearts, watch over our hearts, and be attentive to our hearts.

Jesus continually points to the condition of our hearts.

Action Point:

Psalm 139: 23 - 24 *“Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my concerns. See if there is any offensive way in me; lead me in the everlasting way.”*

Pray and be ready for God to bring situations or circumstances your way that will show you what is in your heart that isn’t pleasing to Him.
